Our Giving Tuesday Projects in the country of Honduras, working with 180 + Christian Churches.

SAFE HOME FOR GIRLS: Honduras is a hub for human trafficking. It has been the murder capital of the world largely controlled by the drug cartels. This is why we need a safe place for girls to grow up until they become a productive part of society. These residents have been brutally abused & are now protected. They have room & board, education, counseling and protection.

GIVE PROVISIONS TO PROTECT A GIRL!

HONDURAN DEAF SCHOOL: Honduras is the second poorest country in our hemisphere. Consequently, deaf Hondurans have little access to education or employment. Our school for the deaf began with a pastor's son who was born deaf. Today, that boy and his mother now run the deaf school filling new lives with hope and light.

GIVE TO ENCOURAGE A CHILD THAT CAN'T HEAR YOUR VOICE!

FEEDING HUNGRY CHILDREN: 66% of Honduras lives below the poverty line. This extreme poverty is especially difficult for the children. Our first large feeding project began at the city dump of La Ceiba in 1991. It still continues to this day. Feeding a child 2 times per week can cost as little as \$5/month.

GIVE TO FEED CHILDREN MEALS IN CITY DUMPS!

EMERGENCY MEDICAL FUND: Emergencies are even more difficult in one of the poorest countries in the world. SOIL ministries has over 20,000 people looking to them for help with family, dental, medical and surgical emergencies. With your help and faith, we can move these mountains.

TEACHING ENGLISH ESL: One in five Hondurans live on less than \$2 per day. ESL classes are offered at local churches to improve both a Honduran's ability to get a job, and to increase their salary. English can also help SOIL to secure them a visa to legally immigrate to the USA.

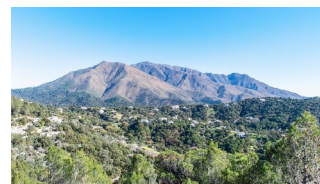

**HONDURAS IS A MOUNTAINOUS COUNTRY
AND IS DIFICULT TO TRAVEL**

We had to cancel planned trips into the mountains of Olancho due to mudslides, washed out roads and flooding over much of the country. We also postponed the Evangelistic Campaign and a week-long training for up to 1300 people hungry to learn the Gospel of Jesus Christ. We are praying for another opportunity to work with Evangelist Alfredo Munos, from Bradenton, Florida sometime in 2023.



This new church needs a roof \$5,000. Their will also be needs for the interior electricity, doors, windows, musical instruments. The estimate for this need is \$2,800.

Construction Project at a Stand Still

A new roof is needed in the state of Olancho. All the walls and the floor are complete. We have close to 180 churches in the mountains, jungles, islands and coastal villages throughout seven states of Honduras. Our 58 years of ministry has always been centered around preaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ first and then working to meet the spiritual, physical, and other humanitarian needs of our

Honduran people as provisions allow. We are in desperate need of transportation. We currently have a KIA truck to transport people, haul food supplies, building supplies, and to transport emergency relief in and out of state. We will also use the new van to transport adults and children back and forth from church, special occasions, medical teams, and a myriad of other adventures that occur on a daily basis in Honduras.

Now we are older and are actually traveling more and are needing more reliable, easier to work on, and safer vehicles as we traverse the rivers, climb the mountains, and enter the interior regions of this mountainous country. Pray, the Lord might do to help us with these more expensive needs.
